GETTING READY FOR EGW 2021:

- The EGW 2021 program is available online on the <u>program schedule</u> website or on the <u>event</u> <u>website</u>. The Program might be adjusted, so you should check the status of your session again ahead of the session.
- This year, EGW will be organized on the SCOOCS platform.
 - NO supplementary registration is needed: To attend the event, a SCOOCS login will be created for you based on the email addresses used for registration to the event.
 - NO specific installation is required to access SCOOCS
- When you are joining a SCOOCS based conference for the 1st time.
 - A pre-created profile will be created for you in Scoocs until the **3rd of September**, based on contact details entered during the registration to the event.
 - All attendees will receive an email by the 3rd of September to log in into Scoocs, using the following link : <u>https://geokarlsruhe2021.scoocs.co/checkin</u>.
 - After completing your profile and choosing your own password, you will be redirected to the conference foyer. Here a short guided tour will show you around the platform and its most important features (first login only). We recommend taking your time to look around and explore everything so that you are familiar with the platform before the conference starts.

GETTING READY FOR YOUR ORAL PRESENTATION

PREPARING YOUR VIDEO:

We would like to promote two easy ways to make your video:

- Using **Zoom**. You can install a personal version of Zoom for free. Open a personal meeting, share your screen with your presentation, and record the talk as you give it. Zoom will save the MP4 file on your computer, which you can then upload to this website.
 - Here's a link to a useful video that shows how to do it:
 - <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WmMSXOQVQs4</u>. Using **Powerpoint**. Later versions of Powerpoint (2013 and later) allow you to record your talk when in SlideShow mode. This adds an audio file to each slide (Office 365 and version

2019 can add a video file also). When you're finished, use Save-As and save as an MP4 file. Then upload to this website.

Of these two, **Zoom is the preferred choice**, because the MP4 file is smaller and it is easier to include yourself in the video.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

 \triangle The duration allowed for your presentation is **12 minutes**. Please do not upload a video that is longer than **12** minutes.

 \triangle As online presentations, your video will work best with an aspect ratio of 16x9, please use that size in your presentation. You may use a slide design of your own choice -- if you would like a template, there is an example <u>here</u>, but you are not required to use this example template.

▲ Please be sure that your voice is **loud and clear**, as the videos will be hard to hear if audio volume is too low. It is best if you pretend that you are speaking in a large room (not sitting in front of your computer) -- project your voice.

HOW TO SUBMIT THE PRE-RECORDED VIDEO:

- All speakers are asked to upload a video of their presentation.
- All speaker videos must be in English.
- We do **not** need your Powerpoint files for the virtual events.
- Please do not upload your video more than once. Check that your video is the way you want it, <u>before</u> uploading. Replacing videos that have already been uploaded is actually quite difficult for us, and may lead to errors in which video finally ends up online.
